## **Electrical Technician**

**Position Location** 

Klamath Falls, OR

**Position Description** 

This position repairs, troubleshoots, modifies, and installs industrial control systems in wood products facilities. Frequent travel of 5 to 14 days per month on average outside of the Klamath Falls area is required in order to perform these duties.

**Position Responsibilities** 

- Must work in a safe manner and comply with all policies and regulations.
- Possess excellent troubleshooting skills with the ability to repair electrical problems, both on site and over the phone.
- Be a positive, proactive self-starter who works well alone and with others.
- Able to continually improve professionally and learn new skills.
- Work in any electrical related activity from construction, to PLC programming, to general troubleshooting.
- Communicate on a daily basis with plant personnel.

**Position Requirements** 

- Minimum 5 years of industrial PLC and electrician experience.
- Strong PLC skills, with experience in program creation and modification.
- Follow and promote plant site electrical and process control standards.
- Proficient in Microsoft Office software, including spreadsheet formulas.
- Learn new technology and be able to transfer the knowledge to others, including supervision, production and maintenance personnel.
- Be proficient with diagnosing and repairing computer hardware and basic networks.
- Diagnose and repair all types of AC circuits to 480 volts, including three phase, single phase, and process controls.
- Ability to use and follow various prints and schematics in order to troubleshoot and repair machine problems.
- Work independently for extended periods.
- Treat others with dignity and respect in a variety of settings.
- Read and apply electrical schematics and equipment manuals.
- Provide own basic tools to perform routine electrical activities.
- Pass an electrical and maintenance written exam administered by Collins.
- This position will require regular travel to provide PLC and electrical assistance at all Collins facilities, nation-wide. Work hours may vary.

## **Physical Requirements** Must have good eye/hand coordination. Vision requirements: Possess the ability to detect differences between colors, including shades of color and brightness. Possess the ability to see details at close range. Hearing Sensitivity-Possess the ability to detect or tell the difference between sounds that vary in pitch and loudness. Must be able to bend, stoop, reach, twist, stand, walk, climb, kneel, carry heavy items; pushing and pulling of weights of up to 50 pounds. **Environmental Conditions** Work takes place inside and outside buildings during all weather conditions, therefore variable temperatures occur. Environment is typically dusty while working on the equipment due to wood fiber. Areas exist where floor surfaces are uneven. Ability to access equipment includes stairs, elevated catwalks, ladders, and powered manlifts. Access may also include climbing over equipment. Able to work in tight/cramped spaces and confined space environments. Wear/use a variety of personal protective and safety equipment per company standards. **Additional Requirements** Must pass drug screen and background checks. All Collins facilities are drug free.
